

Professor Dr Brice De Ruyver

Director, Institute for International Research on Criminal Policy

Professor Dr Brice De Ruyver is a specialist in criminology. As security expert advisor to the Belgian Prime Minister (April 2000 until March 2008) Professor Dr De Ruyver was the architect of the Belgian police reform.

He is currently Director of the Institute for International Research on Criminal Policy (IRCP) and is a Professor at Ghent University attached to the Department of Penal law and Criminology.

Professor De Ruyver has led numerous research projects for the European Commission and several Belgian federal government departments, including Science policy, Justice, Foreign Affairs, and Development Cooperation. He participates in different international networks, including the Council of Europe Pompidou Group, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime and the European Monitoring Centre on Drugs and Drug Addiction) and has published widely on drug policy and criminal policy in general UNODC, and the EMCDDA, and has been widely published on drug policy and criminal policy.
